You will need the following documents to process your application:

Permanent Documents

- Social Security Cards *For everyone on Application
- Identification (Driver's License, Federal State or Local Government ID, Tribal ID, School ID) *For everyone on Application
- Citizenship (U.S Birth Certificate, Naturalization Certificate, Passport, Military Record of service) *For everyone on Application

Temporary Documents

- Residency (A statement from a non-relative, not living with you)
- Income (Paycheck stubs for last 120 Days, a statement from applicant saying that he/she has not worked for last 120 days, or Employment Termination Letter.)
- Expenses (Child Care receipts, Medical Expenses last 120 days, Rent Receipts or Lease, Utilities Statements , Proof of Pregnancy)
